A success for the GEN4OLIVE Open Call: 35 proposals from 63 SMEs received

The GEN4OLIVE Call for Proposals closed on December 1st, reaching successfully results in terms of participation. **63 SMEs** from all the eligible countries submitted **35 proposals**: Italy (11), Spain (10), Greece, (5), France (3), Morocco (3), Turkey (3) and Germany (1).

Now, the GEN4OLIVE consortium will evaluate all these applications to select the best projects that will be funded with grants of 50.000€ for individual

projects and 100.000€ for collaborative projects.

The selected companies will be contacted in March 2022 the latest and will be able to start implementing their projects.

The GEN4OLIVE Call for Proposals will fund olive pre-breeding activities and the development of new technologies that accelerate and make the breeding process more effective.
