The BIO4AFRICA project will support the deployment of the **bioeconomy** in **rural Africa** through the development of value chains and bio-based solutions.

The project will develop a **catalogue of bio-based technologies** adapted to the local needs and context, and it will train farmers in rural Africa to sustainably produce a variety of high value-added bio-based projects, such as animal feed, fertilizers, or biofuels.

BIO4AFRICA has received €9 million in funding from the European Union's **Horizon 2020** [<https://ec.europa.eu/programmes/horizon2020/>] research and innovation programme.
