INTECMED project aims to promote the **development of incubators** to accelerate business innovation, transfer know-how and link the research centres with the European industry.



INTECMED is a strategic project co-funded by the European Union under the [ENI CBC MED programme](http://www.enicbcmmed.eu/) [<http://www.enicbcmmed.eu/>] for **cross-**

border cooperation in the Mediterranean area. It is made up of partners from Greece, Tunisia, Egypt and Spain and has a budget of 3.7 million euros and a duration of 30 months.

The main goal of INTECMED is the development of an **integrated innovation ecosystem** in each of the countries involved to support the transfer of know-how and the commercialisation of research results.
